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## **ENFORCEMENT BULLETIN 2025-003**

EMERGENCY ROAD USE PERMIT LETTER SUPPORTING EXECUTIVE ORDERS  
24-208/ 24-214 and FDOT EMERGENCY ORDERS 24-08/ 24-12

### **Background:**

Executive Orders 24-208 and 24-214 as amended and extended, FDOT Emergency Orders 24-08 and 24-12, as amended and extended authorized the Florida Department of Transportation to relieve the size and weight restrictions for divisible loads on any vehicles transporting emergency equipment, services, supplies, and agricultural commodities in excess of the normal restrictions on weight, height, length, and width restrictions for such vehicles.

Pursuant to this authority, the Florida Department of Transportation issued an Emergency Road Use Permit letter to permit the movement of divisible loads on any vehicles transporting emergency equipment, services, supplies, and agricultural commodities in excess of the normal restrictions on weight, height, length and width.

### **Guidance for Law Enforcement:**

The following agricultural commodities have been identified by the Commissioner of Agriculture and approved by the Secretary of Transportation as covered by the Emergency Road Use Permit letter:

- Silviculture and Forestry Products
