SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF AUTHORIZATION FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE VEHICLES TO BYPASS WEIGH STATION FACILITIES IN RESPONSE TO EXECUTIVE ORDER 24-208, 24-209, 24-213, 24-214, AND 24-215 (EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT - HURRICANE MILTON)

Effective immediately, emergency response vehicles such as, but not limited to, utility vehicles, bucket trucks, and supply trucks responding to Executive Order 24-208, 24-209, 24-213, 24-214, and 24-215 (Emergency Management - Hurricane Milton), are given authorization to bypass all FDOT weigh station facilities through November 4, 2024. This authorization does not include vehicles that require permits to operate on Florida's roadways. This authorization does not relieve size and weight restrictions.

This effort has been coordinated with personnel with the Florida Highway Patrol and the Department of Agriculture to expedite emergency response.
